

ETHIOPIA SEPTEMBER 2025 WORLDWIDE EVANGELISM

Dear friends!

In August, we had a wonderful evangelistic event in Negele. Negele is located 600 km southeast of the capital Addis Ababa, towards the Ethiopian Somali region. It is a dry area and many nomads live there. 95% of the population are Muslims and they had never had a public evangelistic event in the stadium before. We started with a few hundred people and ended on Sunday with several thousand people in the stadium. This morning, Dereje, our coordinator, wrote:

"Good morning, Ekkehard! I have received repeated calls from Negele Borena and had no idea that our evangelism campaign had made such a deep impact. From government officials to church leaders, I am hearing overwhelming reports. Many Muslims have come to Christ, and numerous healings have taken place that we didn't know about because they weren't testified to on stage. The leaders are deeply grateful for this unique evangelism campaign, and we thank God for His faithfulness. Thank you for your unwavering service to our nation, and may God bless you abundantly!"

We were sitting at breakfast and this man was sleeping on the street and at first I thought he was dead. He was a homeless man who had spent the night there. When he woke up, he asked for some money and walked

away. In the evening, I saw him in the stadium as he came forward to the altar call and gave his life to Jesus. One soul less in hell and more in heaven — that's what it's all about.

We printed 1,000 books by Kenneth Hagin in Amharic for the first time. The book has about 400 pages and contains 26 lessons on faith, on prayer, on healing, and on the Holy Spirit and His gifts, each. It is like a mini Bible school. We now give one of these books to the leaders and elders of the various churches at each event, about 100 books per campaign. Most of the leaders are lay people, and this book gives them sound teaching and a foundation.

What we still need is our own stage. We want to order one next year. However, it now costs \$30,000 instead of \$25,000. Everything is becoming more expensive and inflation is very high in Ethiopia. We feel this in our expenses. We planned 12 evangelistic campaigns for Ethiopia and 3 for Nigeria this year, but had to cancel three campaigns in Ethiopia for financial reasons, so we are now conducting 9 campaigns there.

This year, we still will go to Ethiopia twice and to Nigeria twice. The next mission is from September 17-21 in Nigeria.

A heartfelt thank you to all of you who support our work. As long as we have strength, resources, and open doors, we will continue until Jesus comes.


HEALING TESTIMONIES

FAITH IS NOT REASONABLE!

"Faith means that you stop believing what you see and start seeing what you believe!"

Biblical faith is not logical and contradicts our five senses. People generally believe what they can see, hear, smell, touch, and taste, and what they can prove with their minds. But the Bible tells us in Hebrews 11:1 that faith is the evidence of things not seen, of things we cannot prove with our five senses. In the Old Testament, there is a story where the servant of the prophet Elisha looks over the city wall in the morning and sees a huge army surrounding the city to capture the prophet. He feared for his life. Elisha said to him, "Do not be afraid, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them. Lord, open his eyes so that he may see." 2 Kings 6:16. Suddenly, the servant saw a huge army of angels and his fear disappeared. There was more than the eye could see.

We fight the good fight of faith. This means that our "flesh" (mind and emotions) always contradicts the Word of God. This battle takes place within us. One day my wife came home and said, "I have good news for you. I'm pregnant!" But she didn't look pregnant and didn't feel pregnant either. Should we now believe what we see and feel, or what the doctor says? Of course, we believed the doctor. Why don't we believe the Word of God as much as we believe the word of a doctor?

Sixteen-year-old Kenneth Hagin was dying. The doctors had given up on him, and the pastor and his mother were already discussing the funeral. The pastor wanted to comfort him and said, "Son, in a few days it will all be over and you will be delivered from your suffering." A 16-year-old doesn't want to hear that because he wants to live. The boy had been praying for healing for months and nothing had happened. Then one day he said, "Lord Jesus, if You were here in this room and You told me that I had no faith, I would have to tell You that You were lying." He said that he suddenly heard the voice of God and Jesus said to him, "You have faith according to what you know, but you don't know enough.

Doesn't it say in my Word that you first should believe that you have received it, and then it will come to pass?" At that moment, a light dawned on the 16-year-old. He should believe that he is healed while he is still sick in bed, before he sees and feels anything, and then the healing will come to pass. He should believe that he has received healing, and then it will happen. Believe that it has already happened, and then it will happen. Believe that he is healed before he feels or sees anything, and then it will manifest. The boy said, "Lord, I see it!" He prayed one last time in faith for his healing and said, "Lord, I now receive healing for my deformed heart, healing for my blood disease, healing for my paralysis, healing from the top of my head to the soles of my feet. Thank you that I have now received healing according to your word. According to your word, I am healed!"

He was still lying paralyzed and sick in his bed. He said that he began to thank God for his healing and praised Him that he was no longer sick, but healed. As he lay there praising God for his healing, he heard the voice of Jesus again, saying, "You now believe that you are healed. Healthy people should be up at 10 a.m. and not lying in bed, so get up." Faith without works is dead. The boy pulled himself up with his arms on the bed, lifted his dead, paralyzed legs over the edge of the bed, and attempted to stand up. At that moment, he felt life returning to his legs. After 16 months of paralysis, he stood on his own two feet for the first time and was healed.

Faith recognizes as reality what God says; long before our five senses confirm it. Jesus said to a paralyzed man, "You are healed! Take your bed and go home!" The paralyzed man had to first believe that he was healed and that Jesus' word was true before he could get up. Many might have replied, "Can't you see that I am paralyzed? Heal me first, and then I will get up!" But with God, faith comes first, then seeing! Believe in your heart that you are and have what God says you are and have, before you physically see and feel it, and it will come to pass.
