*Evangelism in Uraga & Durame (Ethiopia)*

Dear friends,

In October, it will be 18 years since I first came to Ethiopia, at that time only to visit, not to preach. However, the Ethiopian evangelist I was accompanying said to me, "Since you're here, you can preach on the weekend. I'll take you to a city and pick you up again on Sunday. If nothing happens, you don't need to come back, because they won't invite you again."

I preached on a sports field and remember that a blind woman received her sight and other miracles of healing took place. As a result, I was invited back. My translator at the time was Dereje Tafesse, a student at the *Assemblies of God Bible School*. After Bible school, he became our full-time evangelism director, who has since prepared all evangelism events and taken care of our equipment and vehicles. At that time, he was still single, but now he has a beautiful family (see cover photo) and God has blessed him in every way. We couldn't have asked for a better co-worker. We have been working together for almost 18 years now, and in January we completed our 175th evangelism campaign in Ethiopia.

God's Word says in Proverbs 28:20, "A faithful man abounds with blessings." Now Pastor Dereje has been elected president of the *Evangelical Churches Fellowship of Ethiopia* (ECFE), an association to which almost all Pentecostal-charismatic denominations belong. In total, this association represents over 20 million Christians in Ethiopia.

Many well-known evangelists have been invited to Ethiopia by the ECFE, including Reinhard Bonnke. Pastor Dereje will continue to prepare our evangelistic campaigns and he believes that his election as chairman of the ECFE will only make our campaigns even better.

We are planning a total of 17 evangelistic campaigns in 2026, including 4 in Nigeria. In 2025, we held 13 evangelistic campaigns, including 3 in Nigeria. The total budget is at least €300,000, but most likely more. Our mission is Jesus' Great Commission: to win people for Jesus, heal the sick, cast out demons, and proclaim the baptism into the Holy Spirit. We do what Jesus did, and we experience this in all our evangelistic campaigns.

Please pray for us and help us to fulfill this mission. I believe that we are the last generation that will fulfill Jesus' Great Commission. God's prophetic calendar is: harvest, rapture, Antichrist, apocalypse, and the return of Jesus at the end of the 7-year tribulation period. We want to redeem the time and work as long as the opportunity presents itself. Love and blessings!

# SICK, WEAK AND POOR?

I grew up in a church where we were taught that signs and wonders, spiritual gifts, and speaking in tongues only existed during the first generation of Christians. When the last apostle died, these supernatural signs and wonders ceased. They taught that baptism in the Spirit, speaking in new tongues, apostles, and prophets no longer exist today. There are only pastors, teachers, and evangelists. When perfection came, everything supernatural ceased. By perfection, they meant the Bible, God's Word. Gifts of healing refer to doctors who care for the sick. Speaking in other languages refers to people who are gifted in learning foreign languages or who can translate the Bible into many languages. When praying for the sick, they added: "Lord, heal him if it is Your will." When someone died, they said: "The Lord gave and the Lord has taken away. The Lord's will be done." Whatever happened must have been God's will, they believed, because after all, God had allowed it. But God allows many things that are not His will, because after all, He gave people free will.

The Bible says, "Every good and perfect gift comes from above, from the Father of lights." Jesus said, "The thief comes only to kill, steal, and destroy." Satan is the thief who wants to steal our health, who wants to steal our money, who wants to kill us, who wants to make us poor, weak, and sick, not God.

I grew up thinking that "rich" is bad and "poor" is good. Didn't poor Lazarus go to heaven and the rich man go to hell? Jesus said, "It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for a rich man to enter the kingdom of God." "Whoever loves father, mother, or possessions more than me is not worthy to be my disciple." Is poverty a virtue? Jesus tested the rich young man to reveal the condition of his heart. He wanted to follow Jesus, and Jesus said to him, "Sell everything you have, give the proceeds to the poor, then come and follow me." But he could not do that, because he loved his possessions more than Jesus. His possessions owned him, instead of him owning them. The young man missed a unique opportunity. He could have become one of the 12 apostles, but his possessions meant more to him than

following Jesus. They were his idols. God tested Abraham and asked him to sacrifice his only son. Abraham passed the test, and God blessed him and made Abraham very rich. So God has nothing against wealth, but He is against us setting our hearts on things. In order for God to bless us, we must pass the money test in terms of giving and letting go. God said to a man when he had nothing: "When things no longer mean anything to you, I will give you all things." Today, this man is one of the greatest givers, and God entrusts him with millions. But he sees himself only as a steward, not as an owner.

"It is God who gives you the power to acquire such wealth" (Deuteronomy 8:18) in order to build His kingdom. Money is needed in these last days to bring in the final harvest. "The wealth of the wicked is stored up for the righteous" (Proverbs 13:22), for "the righteous are merciful and give" (Psalm 37:21).

"To the man who pleases him, he gives wisdom, understanding, and joy; but to the sinner he gives the trouble of gathering and heaping up, to give it to him who pleases God" Ecclesiastes 2:26.

Jesus is coming for a glorious church that is strong, healthy, and lacks nothing. That is why we must teach about the power of the Holy Spirit, about healing, and about finances. When Israel left Egypt, there were no sick or poor among them (Psalm 105:37). They plundered the Egyptians and took Egypt's gold and silver with them (Exodus 12:35). The lamb they ate was for their healing. Jesus is our Passover lamb, and by His wounds we were healed. "For mine is the silver and mine is the gold, says the Lord of hosts" (Haggai 2:8). We are partakers of all His goods. What belongs to Him also belongs to us. In faith, we may appropriate everything that already belongs to us in Christ.

"Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth" (3 John 2). God wants you to prosper spiritually, physically, and financially, so much so that you have enough for yourself and can still give to every good work (2 Corinthians 9:8).
